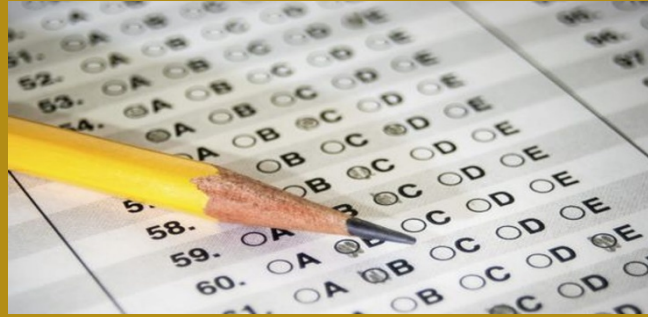

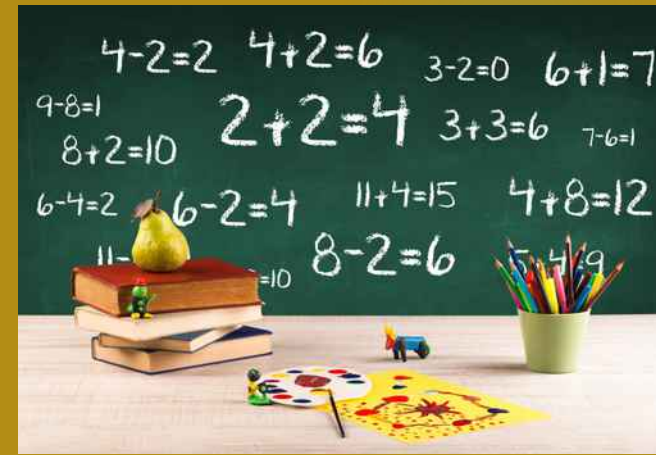

4. ALL SAFETY NET OPTIONS REMAIN IN EFFECT FOR ALL STUDENTS. HOWEVER COMPENSATORY SAFETY NET MAY NOT USE THE EXEMPTION TO COMPENSATE FOR LOWER TEST SCORES.
