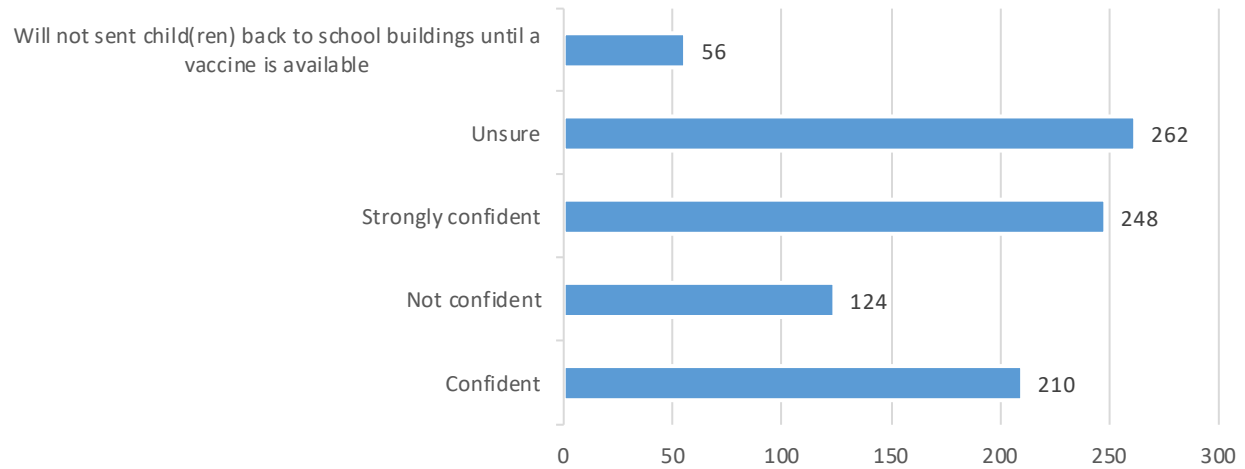
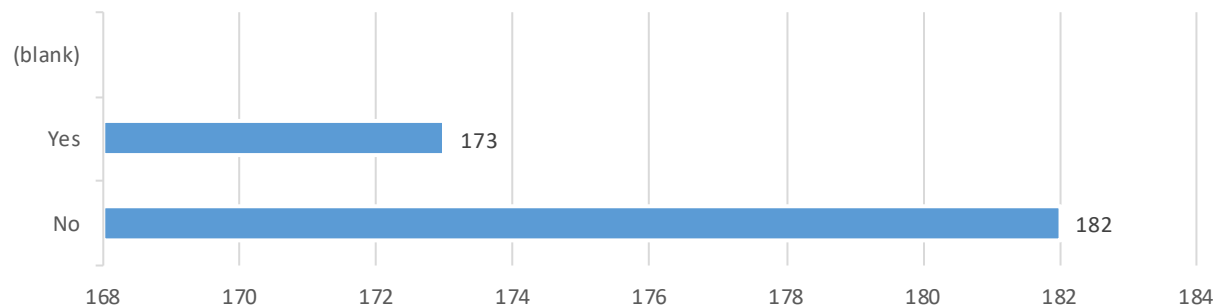


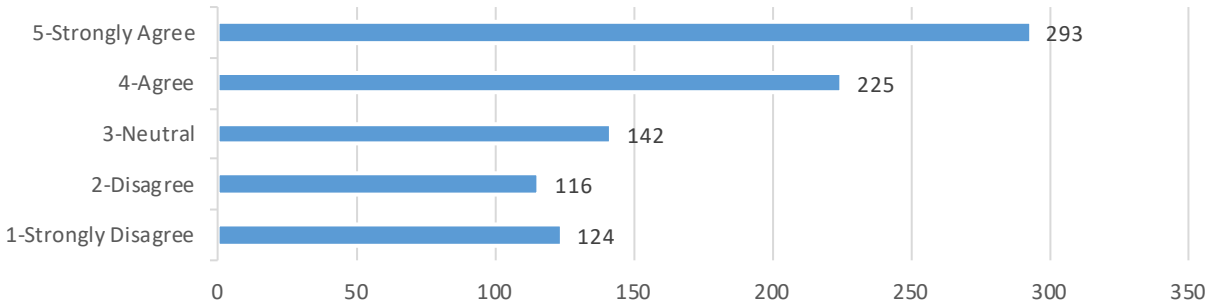
If School Districts will comply with all CDC guidelines, to the best extent possible, to provide a safe and healthy school environment. How confident will you be to send your child back to school knowing this?



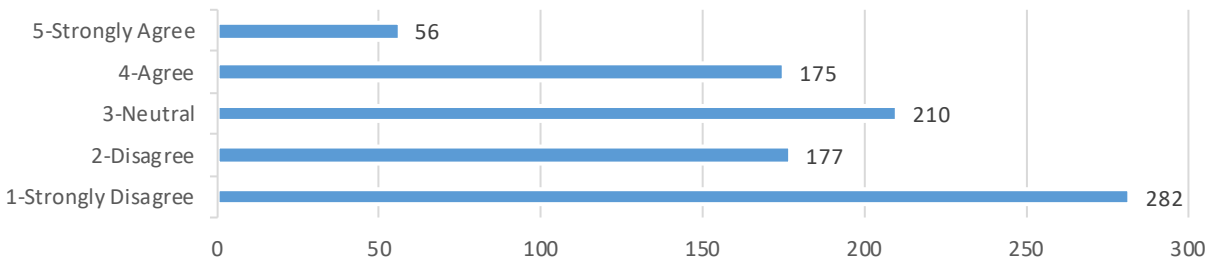
If you have a child that will be of Kindergarten age this Fall, will you be enrolling them in the district if students return to school in September?



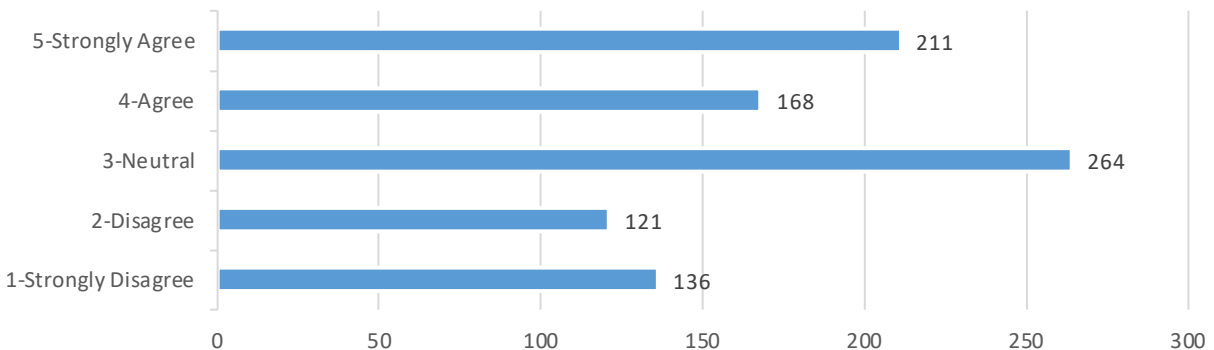
I believe in-person school SHOULD resume as normal, in September, with some new procedures to reduce the spread of illness.



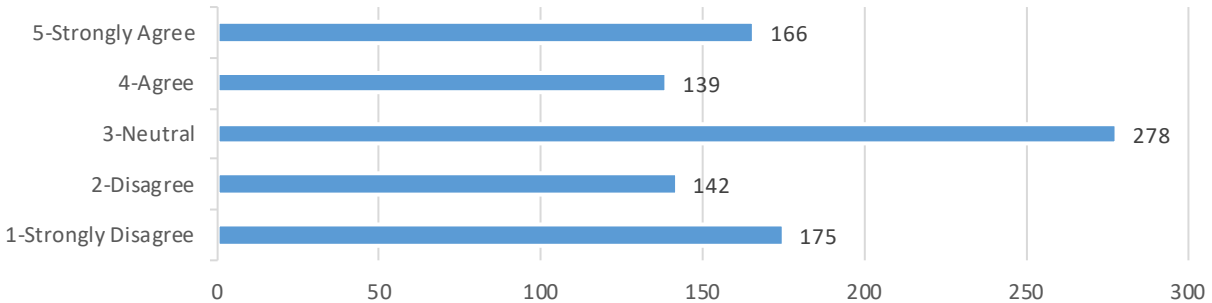
I believe in-person school should resume in September, with HALF of the students ATTENDING SCHOOL on any given day and the other HALF of the students virtually learning from HOME.



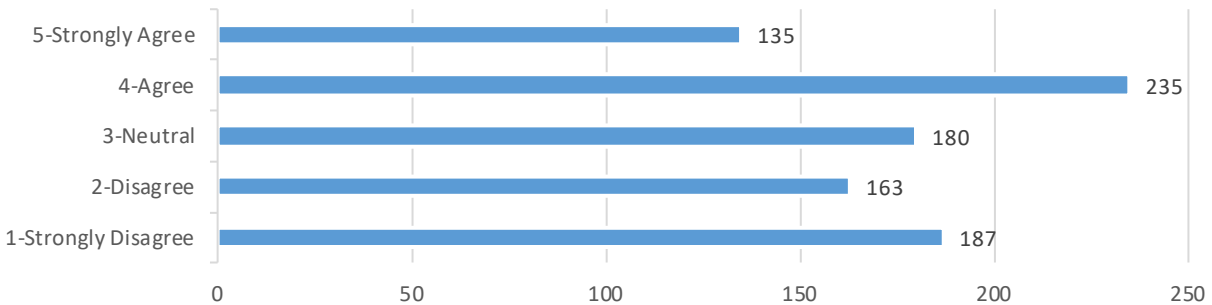
I would transport my child or children to help reduce the number of students on a bus at any given time.



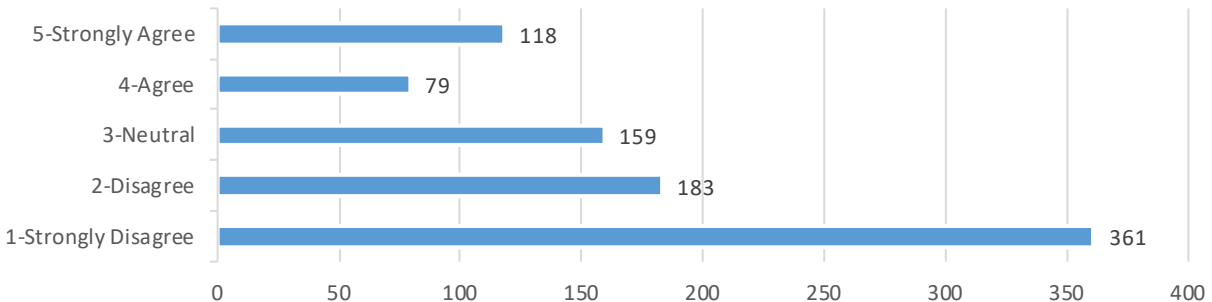
I am comfortable with my child(ren) being transported everyday to and from school on a deep cleaned/sanitized school bus with regular volumes of student passengers.



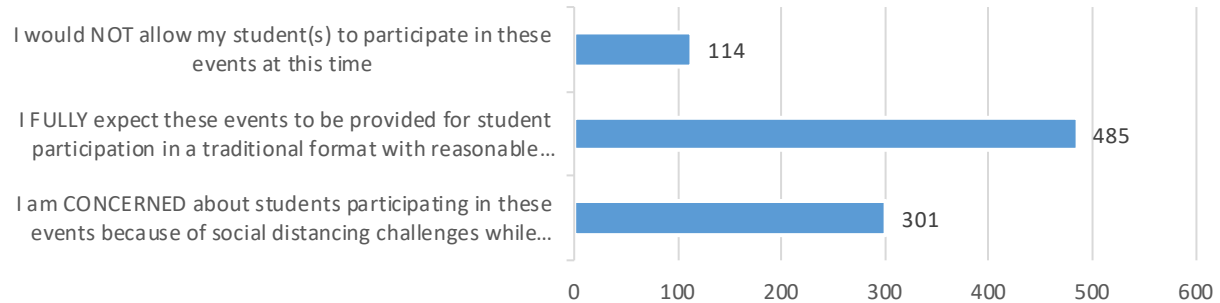
I believe in-person school should resume in September and face coverings should be worn by STAFF and STUDENTS when social distancing is not possible.
